$$2 + (4 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{1000})$$

4) 64.6

$$6 \times 10 + 4 + (6 \times \frac{1}{10})$$

5) 6.3

$$6 + (3 \times \frac{1}{10})$$

6) 88.125

$$8 \times 10 + 8 + (1 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (2 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (5 \times \frac{1}{1000})$$

$$8 \times 10 + 2 + (7 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{1000})$$

12) 16.211

$$1 \times 10 + 6 + (2 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (1 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (1 \times \frac{1}{1000})$$

13) 91.86

$$9 \times 10 + 1 + (8 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (6 \times \frac{1}{100})$$

14) 4.322

$$4 + (3 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (2 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (2 \times \frac{1}{1000})$$

$$5 \times 100 + 5 \times 10 + 3 + (6 \times \frac{1}{10}) + (7 \times \frac{1}{100}) + (9 \times \frac{1}{1000})$$
