2) While playing a trivia game, Team A scored 391 points and Team B scored 129 points. To the nearest ten, how many points were scored total?	<u>ten</u> $390 + 130$ 520	<u>hundred</u> $391 + 129$ $520 = 520$	2. <u>520</u> 3. <u>1,100</u>
3) Two friends were counting the amount of candy they scored for Halloween. James received 213 pieces and Dan received 877 pieces. To the nearest hundred, what is the combined amount they both received?	<u>ten</u> $900 + 200$ 1100	<u>hundred</u> $877 + 213$ $1090 = 1100$	4. <u>1,620</u> 5. <u>890</u>
4) A pet store had 964 goldfish and 659 clown fish. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of both types of fish?	<u>ten</u> $960 + 660$ 1620	<u>hundred</u> $964 + 659$ $1623 = 1620$	6. <u>1,200</u> 7. <u>1,500</u>
5) In a math book, there were 529 problems in chapter one and 363 in chapter two. To the nearest ten, how many problems are there in the first 2 chapters?	<u>ten</u> $530 + 360$ 890	<u>hundred</u> $529 + 363$ $892 = 890$	8. <u>1,000</u> 9. <u>1,600</u>
6) In a month, a video store rented out 300 action movies and 896 other types of movies. To the nearest hundred, what is the sum of the movies they rented in a month?	<u>ten</u> $300 + 900$ 1200	<u>hundred</u> $300 + 896$ $1196 = 1200$	10. <u>1,140</u>
7) Will was playing his favorite video game. In the first round he scored 821 points and in round two he scored 685 points. To the nearest hundred, how many points did he score total?	<u>ten</u> $800 + 700$ 1500	<u>hundred</u> $821 + 685$ $1506 = 1500$	
8) During a 'Super Saturday Sale', a shoe store sold 591 pairs of sneakers and 407 pairs of sandals. To the nearest hundred, what is the total number of shoes the store sold?	<u>ten</u> $600 + 400$ 1000	<u>hundred</u> $591 + 407$ $998 = 1000$	
9) For her birthday Nancy received 966 dollars from her friends and another 593 dollars from her family. To the nearest hundred, how much money would Nancy have total?	<u>ten</u> $1000 + 600$ 1600	<u>hundred</u> $966 + 593$ $1559 = 1600$	
10) At the bank, a customer turned in 993 dimes and 147 nickels. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of coins the customer turned in?	<u>ten</u> $990 + 150$ 1140	<u>hundred</u> $993 + 147$ $1140 = 1140$
