- 6) Sarah was looking through old photo albums. The first had 977 pics and the second had 870. To the nearest ten, how many pictures were there total?

- 8) In a math book, there were 882 problems in chapter one and 681 in chapter two. To the nearest ten, how many problems are there in the first 2 chapters?
- 9) A zoologist was checking the weights of two gorillas. Gorilla A weighed 821 pounds and gorilla B weighed 193 pounds. To the nearest ten, what is the combined weight of both gorillas?
- 10) Maria was preparing for a marathon. In the morning she jogged 870 meters and in the afternoon she jogged another 145 meters. To the nearest ten, how many meters did she jog total?

1) A candy company sells 188 boxes of sugar candy and 949 boxes of chocolate candy every day. To the nearest hundred, what is the sum of the boxes of candy they sell?	ten $200 + 900$ 1100	hundred $188 + 949$ $1137 = 1100$	1. <u>1,100</u>
2) Two friends were counting the number of texts they sent in a month. Alex sent 476 and Jessie sent 921. To the nearest ten, what is the combined amount of texts they sent?	ten $480 + 920$ 1400	hundred $476 + 921$ $1397 = 1400$	2. <u>1,400</u>
3) A pet store had 735 goldfish and 799 clown fish. To the nearest hundred, what is the total number of both types of fish?	ten $700 + 800$ 1500	hundred $735 + 799$ $1534 = 1500$	3. <u>1,500</u>
4) For lunch, 753 students selected chocolate milk and 127 selected regular milk. To the nearest ten, how many milks were taken total?	ten $750 + 130$ 880	hundred $753 + 127$ $880 = 880$	4. <u>880</u>
5) Carl and Amy were collecting cans for recycling. Carl collected 861 cans and Amy collected 438. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of cans they collected?	ten $860 + 440$ 1300	hundred $861 + 438$ $1299 = 1300$	5. <u>1,300</u>
6) Sarah was looking through old photo albums. The first had 977 pics and the second had 870. To the nearest ten, how many pictures were there total?	ten $980 + 870$ 1850	hundred $977 + 870$ $1847 = 1850$	6. <u>1,850</u>
7) John was playing his favorite video game. In the first round he scored 891 points and in round two he scored 900 points. To the nearest ten, how many points did he score total?	ten $890 + 900$ 1790	hundred $891 + 900$ $1791 = 1790$	7. <u>1,790</u>
8) In a math book, there were 882 problems in chapter one and 681 in chapter two. To the nearest ten, how many problems are there in the first 2 chapters?	ten $880 + 680$ 1560	hundred $882 + 681$ $1563 = 1560$	8. <u>1,560</u>
9) A zoologist was checking the weights of two gorillas. Gorilla A weighed 821 pounds and gorilla B weighed 193 pounds. To the nearest ten, what is the combined weight of both gorillas?	ten $820 + 190$ 1010	hundred $821 + 193$ $1014 = 1010$	9. <u>1,010</u>
10) Maria was preparing for a marathon. In the morning she jogged 870 meters and in the afternoon she jogged another 145 meters. To the nearest ten, how many meters did she jog total?	ten $870 + 150$ 1020	hundred $870 + 145$ $1015 = 1020$	10. <u>1,020</u>
