Nancy had \$5.00 when she went to the store. If she bought 1 music box what is the most expensive item she can buy with the money she has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$1.75 = \$3.25$$

lollipop	\$3.75
chocolate bar	\$1.10
gummy worm	\$3.00
sugar cube	\$1.00

Roger had \$5.00 when he went to the shop. If he bought 1 gummy worm what is the most expensive item he can buy with the money he has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$3.00 = \$2.00$$

- 4) The table below shows the prices of several items at the game store.

Item	Price
figurine	\$1.50
pack of stickers	\$2.40
poster	\$3.75
trading card	\$2.15
guide book	\$2.60

Faye had \$5.00 when she went to the store. If she bought 1 pack of stickers what is the most expensive item she can buy with the money she has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$2.40 = \$2.60$$

- 6) The table below shows the prices of several items at the baseball game.

Item	Price
hotdog	\$2.20
soda	\$1.10
corndog	\$2.45
small fry	\$3.95
burger	\$3.90

Billy had \$5.00 when he went to the game. If he bought 1 soda what is the most expensive item he can buy with the money he has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$1.10 = \$3.90$$
