 $\$5.00 - \$2.40 = \$2.60$

hotdog	\$2.20
soda	\$1.10
corndog	\$2.45
small fry	\$3.95
burger	\$3.90

Billy had \$5.00 when he went to the game. If he bought 1 soda what is the most expensive item he can buy with the money he has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$1.10 = \$3.90$$
